Feed at a rate to provide 22.7 mg Decoquinate (.04 lb. or .64 oz.) per 100 lbs. of bodyweight daily. Feed for at least 28 days during periods of coccidiosis exposure or when experience indicates that coccidiosis is likely to be a hazard.
